**4.1 Charging Policy**

Do the Council agree with the proposed charging policy in Appendix 1 to Appendix A? If not what general principles would the Council recommend to WHBC?

**4.2 Whitehill Car Park**

The Council to consider the refurbishment of the Whitehill Car Park in tandem with the introduction of parking restrictions by WHBC (completed by March 2012)

**4.3 Lockleys Drive car park:**

Do the Council agree that car parking charges in Lockleys Drive car park should be implemented Monday to Friday inclusive? Between what times of day? Is the proposed tariff appropriate? Does the Council agree with splitting the car park in two, 50% long stay parking for permit holders and 50% short stay pay and display parking?

The Clerk has already requested that four spaces be allocated for Parish Council use, two opposite the Parish centre and two in the long stay section of the car park.

**4.4 High Street Car Park**

Do the Council agree that car parking charges for the High Street car park should be implemented Monday to Saturday inclusive? Between what times of day? Is the proposed tariff appropriate?

**4.5 Hertford Road Parking Bay**

Do the Council agree with the restrictions proposed in the parking bay in Hertford Road adjacent to the Recycling Centre in the Civic Centre?

**4.6 Proposed Non Restricted Areas**

Councillors present at the 10<sup>th</sup> August meeting recommend that no restrictions be implemented in the following areas and these areas be considered at a later date if problems of displacement are experienced: Under this Council's control: Civic Centre car park: Civic Centre turning circle at the front of the Centre: Ottway Walk car park
